**CHANGES MADE BY THIS TARIFF:**

**EXTENSION ROUTE DISCONTINUED**

Beginning at the intersection of Baltimore Pike, Conchester Highway and Conchester Road located in the Township of Concord, thence via Conchester Road, LaCrue Avenue, Aldan Avenue and Evergreen Drive to the intersection of Evergreen Drive and Franklin Drive.

**EXTENSION ROUTE ADDED**

Beginning at the intersection of Baltimore Pike, Conchester Highway and Conchester Road located in the Township of Concord, thence via Conchester Highway and Evergreen Drive to the intersection of Evergreen Drive and Franklin Drive.

**ROUTE 111 – 69<sup>TH</sup> STREET TERMINAL TO PENN STATE UNIVERSITY  
AND CHADDS FORD**

**BASE ROUTE**

**Westbound:**

Beginning on SEPTA private property located in the Township of Upper Darby (69<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal – West Terminal), thence via West Chester Pike, State Road, U.S. Route 1 (Media Bypass), Baltimore Pike, private property of Granite Run Mall, Baltimore Pike, private property of Riddle Memorial Hospital, private property of Granite Run Mall, Middletown Road, Old Forge Road, private property of Fair Acres Geriatric Center, Old Forge Road, Middletown Road and private property of Penn State University located in the Township of Middletown.

**Eastbound:**

Beginning on private property of Penn State University located in the Township of Middletown, thence via Middletown Road, Old Forge Road, private property of Fair Acres Geriatric Center, Old Forge Road, Middletown Road, private property of Granite Run Mall, Baltimore Pike, private property of Riddle Memorial Hospital, Baltimore Pike, U.S. Route 1 (Media Bypass), State Road and West Chester Pike to SEPTA private property located in the Township of Upper Darby (69<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal – West Terminal).

**ALTERNATE ROUTES (to be operated as required):**

1. Beginning at the private property of Granite Run Mall with its intersection with Baltimore Pike located in the Township of Middletown, thence via Baltimore Pike to the intersection of Baltimore Pike and Pennell Road; to be operated in either direction.
2. Beginning at the intersection of Baltimore Pike, Conchester Highway and Conchester Road located in the Township of Concord, thence via Baltimore Pike to the intersection of Baltimore Pike and Brinton Lake Road; to be operated in either direction.

**EXTENSION ROUTE (to be operated as required)**

Beginning at the intersection of Middletown Road and Pennell Road located in the Township of Middletown, thence via Pennell Road, Baltimore Pike (U.S. Route 1), private property of Franklin Mint, Baltimore Pike (U.S. Route 1), Conchester Highway, Evergreen Drive, Franklin Drive, Brinton Lake Road, Baltimore Pike, private property of Applied Card Systems, State Farm Drive, Baltimore Pike, U.S. Route 202 (Wilmington Pike), and Christy Drive to near the intersection of Christy Drive and U.S. Route 202 located in the Township of Chadds Ford; returning via Christy Drive, Dickinson Drive, Baltimore Pike (U.S. Route 1), U.S. Route 202 (Wilmington Pike), State Farm Drive, private property of Applied Card Systems, Baltimore Pike (U.S. Route 1), Brinton Lake Road, Franklin Drive, Evergreen Drive, Conchester Highway, Baltimore Pike, private property of Franklin Mint, Baltimore Pike and Pennell Road to the intersection of Pennell Road and Middletown Road located in the Township of Middletown.
