**CHANGES MADE BY THIS TARIFF:**

**BASE ROUTE DISCONTINUED**

Beginning at the intersection of Chemical Road where it intersects with the driveway leading to private property of the Metroplex Shopping Center located in Plymouth Township, thence via Chemical Road and Germantown Pike to the intersection of Germantown Pike and Chemical Road.

**BASE ROUTE ADDED**

Beginning on private property of the Metroplex Shopping Center where it intersects with Gallagher Road located in Plymouth Township, thence via Gallagher Road, Belvoir Road, Johnson Road and Plymouth Road to the intersection of Plymouth Road and Germantown Pike.

**EXPERIMENTAL IMPLEMENTATION**

If adopted by the SEPTA Board, this tariff, as supplemented, will be implemented on an experimental basis for an initial period of six months, once renewable for a maximum period of one year. A report will be made to the SEPTA Board at the conclusion of the first experimental period to determine whether or not to continue the change(s) described in the tariff for a second six-month period, discontinue the change(s), or make the change(s) permanent. Should the Board decide that the change(s) described in the supplement to the tariff be continued for a second six-month period, a report will be made to the SEPTA Board at the conclusion of the second six-month experimental period with a recommendation to discontinue the change(s) or make the change(s) permanent without an additional public hearing. If after either experimental period, the decision of the Board is to discontinue the change(s), a public notice will be posted and advertised. Should any revisions to the change(s) be proposed as a result of the experimental operation, a new supplement to the tariff would be filed and a new public hearing would be held.

**BASE ROUTE**

**Northbound:**

Beginning on SEPTA private property of Gulph Mills Station located in the Township of Upper Merion, thence via Trinity Lane, Swedeland Road, Renaissance Boulevard, Horizon Boulevard, Church Road, Feheley Drive, Hertzog Boulevard, Flint Hill Road, B Street, River Road, private property of Philadelphia Newspapers Incorporated, River Road, Front Street, Fayette Street, Elm Street, Fayette Street, Butler Pike, Ridge Pike, Chemical Road, private property of Metroplex Shopping Center, Gallagher Road, Belvoir Road, Johnson Road, Plymouth Road and Germantown Pike to private property of Plymouth Meeting Mall located in the Township of Plymouth.

**Southbound:**

Beginning on private property of Plymouth Meeting Mall located in the Township of Plymouth, thence via Hickory Road, Germantown Pike, Plymouth Road, Johnson Road, Belvoir Road, Gallagher Road, Chemical Road, private property of Metroplex Shopping Center, Gallagher Road, Chemical Road, Ridge Pike, Butler Pike, Fayette Street, Elm Street, Harry Street, Stoddard Street, Apple Street, Elm Street, Fayette Street, Front Street, River Road, private property of Philadelphia Newspapers Incorporated, River Road, B Street, Flint Hill Road, Hertzog Boulevard, Feheley Drive, Church Road, Horizon Boulevard, Renaissance Boulevard, Swedeland Road and Trinity Lane to SEPTA private property of Gulph Mills Station located in the Township of Upper Merion.
